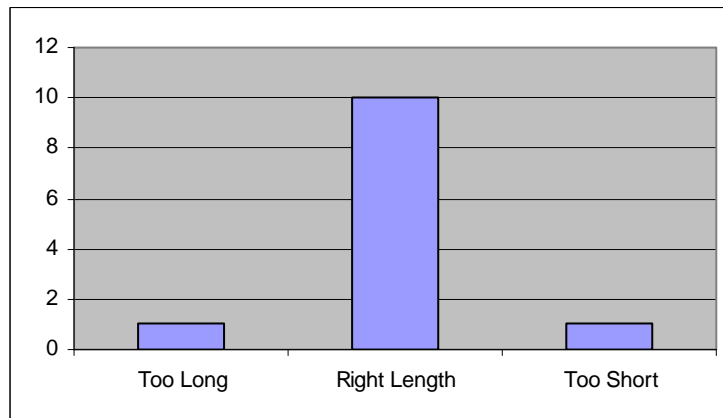

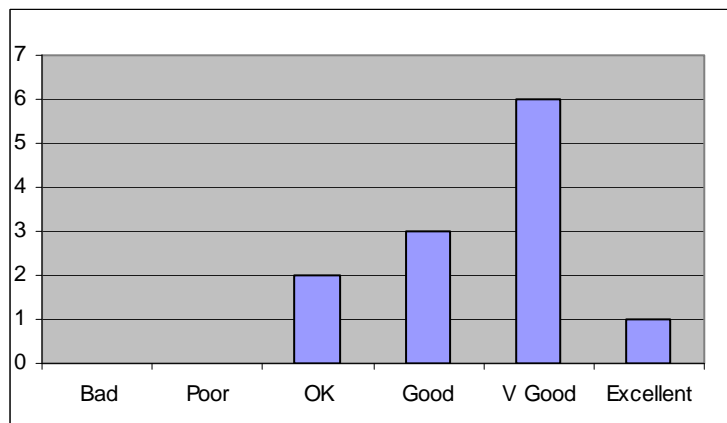

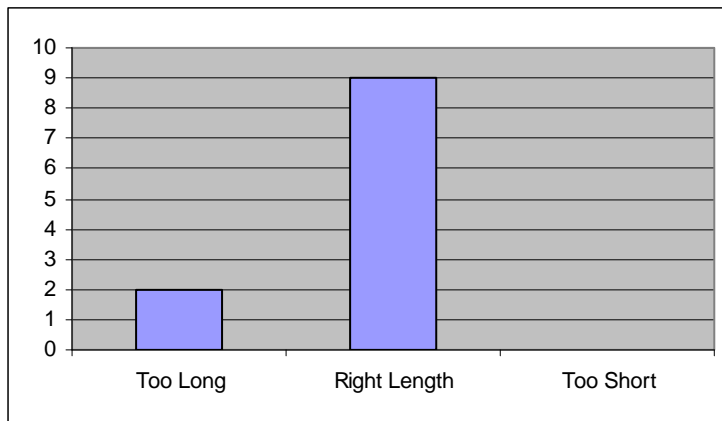

'More clinical examples would be good and +ve ones'

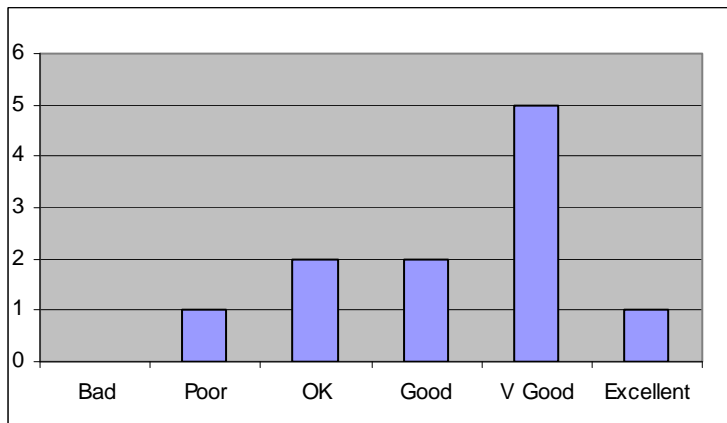
